CAROLINA BEACH LAKE MAINTENANCE

SECTION 00100 – INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Carolina Beach is currently seeking bids for the construction of the Carolina Beach Lake Maintenance Project. This is a single prime contract and all prospective bidders must possess the appropriate license and resources to complete the project in its entirety. Each bidder must show evidence it is an appropriately licensed contractor under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. All work within the Bid Documents shall be completed by May 30, 2018. Work activity will occur within two construction windows (1) October 1, 2016 to May 30, 2017; and (2) October 1, 2017 to May 30, 2018. The Contractor will be required to return all disturbed areas around the lake to pre-project conditions or better at the conclusion of each construction window.

The Carolina Beach Lake Maintenance Project proposes the removal of accumulated sediment through conventional means of land based equipment, including clam shell bucket loader, backhoe, and barge. Maintenance will include the removal of approximately 83,200 cubic yards of material, up to an average depth of six (6) feet below the current 11.8 acre lake bottom. Excavation shall result in the creation of a stable profile to insure the integrity of the lake bank and the internal wetland islands. Spoil material management shall be consistent with regulatory requirements and be transported and stockpiled using designated routes and spoil areas. Spoil shall to be transported by means of sealed trucks to a designated disposal site located at the Towns wastewater treatment facility within the Sunny Point buffer area.

Contractors must be prequalified with the Town of Carolina Beach, in order to bid on this project. Pre-Qualification Packages shall be obtained from and submitted to SEPI Engineering & Construction, Inc. The last day for bidders to submit Pre-Qualification Packages to SEPI is Thursday, November 10, 2016. No bids will be accepted from Contractors that are not pre-qualified with the Town of Carolina Beach.

A Pre-Bid Meeting (not mandatory) will be held on November 15, 2016 at 2:00 PM, in the conference room at SEPI Engineering & Construction, Inc., 5030 New Centre Drive, Suite B, Wilmington, NC 28403.

A Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the contract value is required. Additional information with regard to the project, including required insurance and other bonding requirements, is included in the Bid Package.

The minority business participation goal for this project is ten percent (10%). All of the required MBE Forms shall be included by the bidder as part of the bid package. Bidders shall be responsible understanding all of the federal, state, and local MBE requirements.

The bids shall be marked “Carolina Beach Lake Maintenance Project” and shall be received until 12:00 PM, on November 28, 2016. All bids will be publicly read at 2:00 PM, on November 28, 2016, in the Town of Carolina Beach Council Chambers, located at 1121 N. Lake Park Boulevard, Town of Carolina Beach 28428. No electronic or faxed submittals of bids will be accepted.

The Town of Carolina Beach reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The Town of Carolina Beach will negotiate a final contract with the successful bidder.
