



***PROCLAMATION NO. 04-565***

***Proclamation of a County State of Emergency***

***WHEREAS***, the governing body of the Town of Carolina Beach has duly adopted an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to determine and proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to impose various restrictions after he determines that such restrictions are necessary as a response to an emergency.

***NOW, THEREFORE***, I, Dennis T. Barbour, Mayor of the Town of Carolina Beach proclaim:

An emergency exists, and restrictions set forth in this proclamation are necessary in order to maintain an acceptable level of public order, services, and protection of lives, safety, and property during this emergency.

I proclaim the following restrictions:

In the best interest of the public safety and protection, it is necessary to evacuate the civilian population from the Town of Carolina Beach. A voluntary evacuation will begin immediately to be completed by 9:00 a.m., August 14, 2004.

This proclamation shall take effect immediately, 4:30 p.m., August 13, 2004.
