### **CAROLINA BEACH POLICE SEEKING SUSPECTS IN ATTEMPTED MURDER AND ASSAULT**

CAROLINA BEACH, NC --- A Carolina Beach man was shot and wounded by two of his roommates early this morning, police said. The man was taken to New Hanover County Regional Medical Center where he was undergoing surgery at the time of this release. No further information is available on his condition at this time.

The Carolina Beach Police Department said they received an emergency notification of an accidental shooting at 1406 Pinfish Lane at 3:21 a.m. on January 15, 2005. An investigation revealed two Hispanic males became involved in an altercation with Mr. Sergio Balsaquez Perez, a Hispanic male, born 01/09/78, who resided at 1406 Pinfish Lane with the others. Mr. Perez and his roommates are a group of construction workers who work for a Raleigh construction firm. (The name of the company is unknown at this time.)

The group had gone out to The Scorpio, a Wilmington bar, prior to returning to their residence. Mr. Perez returned later than his roommates and was shot upon entering their trailer. Witnesses state the two suspects shot Mr. Perez who sustained wounds to the leg and abdomen. The suspects are two Hispanic males whose first names are Cavino and David. Last names are unknown at this time. They fled the area in a 1985-90 yellow Chevrolet Camaro which had a black leather auto bra on its front and damage to the right rear. The license plate number is unknown. Both suspects are believed to be from the Raleigh/Durham area and may be heading in that direction, police said.
