### ***Town of Carolina Beach Announces Rescheduled Date for “Community Day in the Park” and Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Wheel Fun Rentals Paddle Boats at the Lake***

CAROLINA BEACH, NC---Mark your calendar for the third Saturday in May. They will have the ribbon-cutting ceremony for their new paddleboat rides at the same time and will offer rides at discounted rates.
