**Amend Appendix A Zoning,
Article 1 General Provisions**

Sec. 1.8. Relationship among Town Ordinances to other laws.


(a) To other laws It is not intended by this ordinance to repeal, abrogate, annul or in any way to impair or interfere with other Town ordinances not contained in the zoning ordinance.

(b) Zoning Provisions. When inconsistencies are identified within the zoning ordinance, the more restrictive shall apply.


~~any existing provisions of law or ordinance, other than the zoning ordinance superseded by this ordinance, or any rules, regulations or permits previously adopted or issued, or which shall be adopted or issued, in conformity with law, relating to the use of buildings or premises, nor is it intended by this ordinance to interfere with or abrogate or annul any easements, covenants or other agreements between parties; provided, however, that where this ordinance imposes a greater restriction upon the use of buildings or premises or upon the height of buildings or requires larger yards, courts, or other open spaces than are imposed or required by such existing provisions of law or ordinance or by such rules, regulations or permits, or by such easements, covenants or agreements, the provisions of this ordinance shall control.~~
