



**ORDINANCE NO. 09-799**

***Order in the Matter of Renaming  
188 Ft of the 600 Block of South Second Street  
to Lake Drive***

It appearing to the Town Council of the Town of Carolina Beach that a public hearing was held on this date, at which time all persons were heard on the question of whether or not the renaming would be in the public interest, and it further appearing that notice of said hearing was published in a local newspaper in accordance with town policy, and it further appearing that notice of said hearing was prominently posted along said street, and the Town Council is on the opinion that 188 ft. of the 600 Block of South Second Street should be renamed of same is in the public interest, the legal description of said 600 Block of South Second Street being as follows:

Rename 188 ft. of the 600 Block of S. Second Street to Lake Drive (identified in New Hanover County Tax Records as 4 addresses: 601 S. Second Street, 603 S. Second Street, 605 S. Second Street and 607 S. Second Street) (see map identified as Exhibit 1 herein attached)

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AND DECREED that the above described 188 ft. of the 600 Block of South Second Street is hereby renamed as follows:

Lake Drive

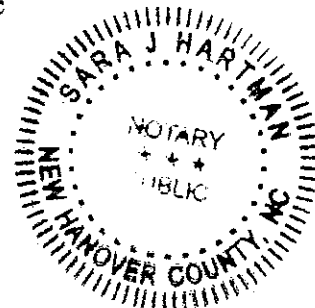
