WINDSHIELD PLACEMENT

This decal is to be affixed to the lower left hand corner of the vehicles inside windshield.

TO APPLY

Clean surface to which the decal will be applied to. Peel decal and apply.

NO: ATV'S, MOTORCYCLES OR GLASS BOTTLES

Instructions to permit holder: Do not attempt to remove this permit once it has been adhered to your windshield. The permit is designed for a single placement and will destruct upon removal. Any tampering will result in a voided permit. If you sell your vehicle, bring in your removed sticker for replacement.

Permits are **NON REFUNDABLE** and **NONTRANSFERABLE**. Permits are issued to the vehicle, not the operator, and must remain on the assigned vehicle. Purchaser will be responsible for the full purchase price of a new permit if the permit or vehicle is lost, stolen, damaged or transferred.

Freeman Park Rules and Regulations

Dunes

Do not walk or drive on the dunes or disturb the dune fencing and signs. This is a no trespassing area subject to fines of \$100.00 up to \$1,000.00 and may result in immediate permit revocation.

Litter

Littering of any kind is strictly prohibited. Do not leave any type of trash on beach. This includes but is not limited to cigarette butts, fishing tackle, campfire remains, pet waste, and other trash. Littering fines are \$50.00 for first violation and \$100.00 for each following violation. Waste water from self-contained vehicles must be kept in a holding tank and may **NOT** be emptied in Freeman Park. Wooden shipping palettes may not be burned within the Freeman Park boundaries.

Driving on the Beach

Maximum speed limit for driving on the beach is **15 mph**.

No vehicles parking or driving on wet sand. No driving is allowed between the water line and the high tide crest.

Cutting circles or otherwise defacing the beach is prohibited. Be safe and courteous to others.

Campfires

Campfires must be in approved fire containers. Camping and/or fires in designated areas only (Zone 6 -24).

No camping or fires are allowed within 25 feet of dune or vegetation line.

Burning of trash or construction grade materials is not allowed. Natural wood only. Fires may not be left unattended and must be extinguished with water, **NOT SAND**. You must clean up after your fire.

Pets

Dogs must be kept away from dune area. They must be controlled at all times. Pets must be on a leash April 1 - Sept 30.

Do not allow your pet to disturb others. Clean up after pet. Failure to do so, \$50 fine.

Sea Turtles & Other Wildlife

Sea Turtles are protected by the Endangered Species Act. It's unlawful to harass, harm, capture or collect sea turtle eggs, live or dead hatchlings, juveniles or adults. Violators can be prosecuted. Do not shine lights or snap flash photos at wildlife. Turn off all lights in the immediate vicinity of turtle nests.
