

Greenhouse

The town's greenhouse produces hundreds of thousands of sea oats for sale to coastal homeowners, businesses and other beach communities. Sea oats are indigenous to this region and are used for the protection of coastal sand dunes. They are capable of trapping large quantities of sand during their first growing season. The greenhouse also produces bitter panicum, another successful dune stabilization plant indigenous to this region.

The following plants are available for sale at the town's greenhouse located at 404 S. Dow Rd., Carolina Beach:
