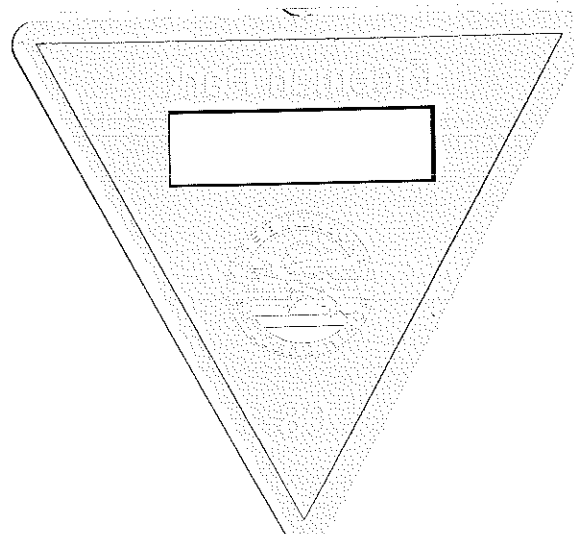

WINDSHIELD PLACEMENT

This decal is to be affixed to the lower left hand corner of the vehicles inside windshield above the state inspection sticker.

TO APPLY

Clean surface to which the decal will be applied to.
Peel decal and apply.



Instructions to permit holder: Do not attempt to remove this permit once it has been adhered to your windshield. The permit is designed for a single placement and will destruct upon removal. Any tampering will result in a voided permit. If you sell your vehicle, bring in your removed sticker for replacement.

Permits are **NON REFUNDABLE** AND **NONTRANSFERABLE**. Permits are issued to the vehicle, not the operator, and must remain on the assigned vehicle. Purchaser will be responsible for the full purchase price of a new permit if the permit or vehicle is lost, stolen, damaged or transferred.
