## New Recycling Schedule

Waste Industries changed recycling dates for some residents on the island, effective March 30, 2015. Every resident had recycling serviced on the same biweekly schedule and now WI is servicing on a Week A and Week B schedule. Hopefully everyone is used to their new schedule if it was changed. ## What should not be placed in my Recycling Cart?

As Earth Day just passed on April 22, it is always a great reminder to recycle. Your normal recyclable items: paper items, cardboard, glass/plastic bottles and aluminum cans can be placed right into the recycling carts. Waste Industries sorts the items so we don't have to!

Please keep in mind that there are some items that do not belong in the recycling cart.

- No bagged material
- No waxed boxes, waxed bags or waxed paper
- No hard cover books, no dark colored paper or file folders
  - No plastic bags of any kind
  - No Styrofoam of any kind
- No mirrors windows or auto glass
  - No light bulbs
  - No coat hangers
  - No ceramics
- No antifreeze containers
  - No paint cans
- No plastic medical waste or plastic that has come in contact with petroleum or hazardous waste
  - **No construction debris**
  - **No YARD DEBRIS (See next section)**

## Yard Debris

The Town of Carolina Beach offers one truck load of yard debris to be removed once a quarter at no charge. Branches will need to be 4' or less and small items bagged and placed at the curb. The town often uses a backhoe to pick up large piles. Care should be taken not to place the debris pile over **meter boxes, cable boxes, phone boxes, manholes, etc.**
