Proclamation of State of Emergency***

Pursuant to Chapter 2, Article IV, Section 2-63 "Declaration of Emergency", The Carolina Beach Town Council has determined that a State of Emergency as defined in the Carolina Beach Code of Ordinances exists in Carolina Beach.

The Carolina Beach Town Council proclaims the existence of a State of Emergency in Carolina Beach due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Carolina Beach Town Council hereby orders all town law enforcement officers and all personnel to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of the town emergency ordinances, which are set forth below and in effect immediately:

- Beach Accesses will be closed
- All public parking lots will be closed
- Freeman Park will be closed
